Please avoid of intense hit or drop on the product .

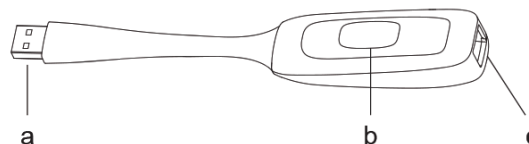
### Cable

## ▪ Button and Interface

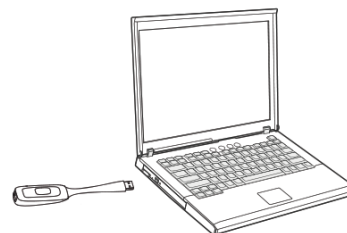


- a. USB type A: connect with the PC
- b. Button: click to present/stop to present the screen and sound
- c. USB type B: connect with the standardized USB cable

## ▪ Connection Instructions

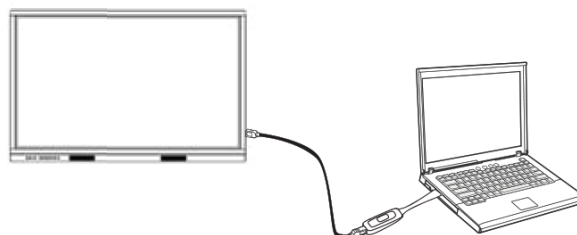
This product needs to be used with the Interactive Flat Panel (IFP) .

Step 1:



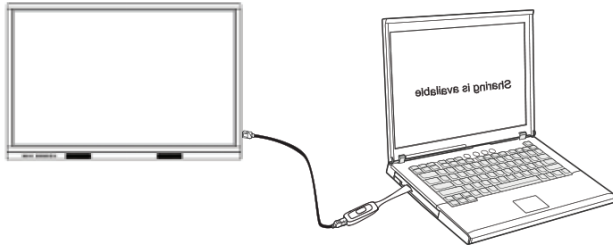
For the first-time use, connect the EasiCable to your PC and operate the driver manually (the driver will run automatically along subsequent connection).

Step 2:



Turn on the IFP, connect the EasiCable to the side USB port of IFP with the standard USB touch cable.

Step 3:



Click the button to share your screen and sound, when your PC pops out a prompt “Sharing is available”.

▪ **Instruction of the state indicator**

Blinking indicates the device is on to way to be connected.

Lighting indicates the device has already been connected.

▪ **Function Introduction**

1. Supports to present the screen and sound of your PC to the IFP.
2. Supports to present the screen and sound of your PC to the IFP as an extended screen.
3. Supports to control your PC from the IFP side.

▪ **Troubleshooting**

When the device cannot be connected, please have a check as following:

1. Make sure the USB touch cable is connecting with the side USB port of IFP, instead of the front USB port or other module’s USB ports.
2. Make sure the driver of EasiCable is running properly on your PC.
3. Try again to connect the Easicable.
